

## Winery Licenses – Guidelines and Application

If you are interested in establishing a Winery in Newfoundland and Labrador please use the following as a **guideline** of the requirements. *Please note: other agencies or departments may require information further to that which is listed below.*

<b>Newfoundland Labrador Liquor Corporation (NLC) License Requirements</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completed application for a Winery license (see attached)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completed Personal Data Sheets (enclosed) for all shareholders or directors</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Current Certificate of Conduct for all Directors and shareholders</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written Municipal approval</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written approval from the Provincial Fire Commissioner's Office</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One set of floor plans, drawn to scale on paper no larger than 8.5" x 14", outlining the proposed licensed area, including dimensions of clearly identified rooms (including storage)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A current signed copy of a lease or purchase agreement, or another document that verifies ownership and/or legal possession of the establishment</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If incorporated, please provide Notice of Directors form, <i>The Corporations Act</i> (Form 6)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written approval from the Canada Revenue Agency (<i>see CRA section below</i>)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verification of Food Establishment License (<i>see Service NL section below</i>)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written approval from Buildings Accessibility and Fire &amp; Life Safety (<i>see Service NL section below</i>)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Once all information is collected, a pre-licensing inspection will be conducted</li> </ul>	
<p><b>NLC Product Approvals and Reporting</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As you move through the process, it is important for you to consult with NLC's Merchandising Department, which is responsible for the products approved and sold by wineries. A fixed and variable markup component is applied to your cost which is the NLC markup. For more information on pricing, please contact our Supervisor of Revenue Assurance and Pricing, Roy LeGrow, at (709) 724-1123 or <a href="mailto:roy.legrow@nliquor.com">roy.legrow@nliquor.com</a>.</li> <li>• Winery licensees will be required to file a monthly commission report to the NLC which tracks your inventory, production and sales and will detail the amount of commission due to the NLC. Commission due to NLC must be paid monthly in accordance with policy. Adequate records to support amounts reported are to be maintained. Licensed wineries are also subject to audits by the NLC.</li> </ul>	

<b>Other Agency Requirements – Winery License</b>	
<p><b>Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)</b></p> <p>CRA issues the license to produce wine in Canada and will assist with any production questions you may have. For more information, please contact the Regional Manager – Excise Duty at (902) 450-8374 or 1-888-327-7999.</p>	
<p><b>Service NL</b></p> <p>To operate a winery, a Food Establishment License is required. Service NL conducts health inspections at all food establishments in the province, including wineries.
