Award Design for Newfoundland Labrador Liquor Corporation's 2019 President's Award

The Newfoundland Labrador Liquor Corporation's (NLC) President's Award was designed to honour special companies, organizations, individuals and employees for their outstanding contribution, voluntary commitment and dedication to social responsibility.



In 2015, the inaugural award was designed and handcrafted by local artist Florence Donaway. Her piece, the *Tree of Life Cup*, represented the ideals of achievement, commitment, and actions that affirm life.

In 2016, the award was created by award-winning artist Urve Manuel. Her creation of a glass salmon symbolized the determination of award recipients who, like salmon facing a difficult upstream migration, overcome challenges in achieving their goals to make the world a better place.



Last year, the award selected was a glass Tuckamore tree designed by Brian Power of Seafire Glass. The Tuckamore, known for its ability to survive and thrive in a harsh coastline environment represented beautifully the strength and resiliency displayed by our award recipients.

In keeping with our commitment to promote local artists, NLC is now seeking someone to create and craft our 2019 President's Award. This is a great opportunity for artists working in any medium to gain exposure for their artwork which, if selected, will be showcased at our award ceremony.

Invitation: Artists are invited to provide concepts for the design and creation of an award to be given to recipients at the fourth annual President's Awards luncheon in Spring 2019.

Eligibility: This invitation is open to local or regional artists who live/work/attend school in the province.

Deadline: Submissions should include a brief proposal of the artist's design and must be received by **October 31, 2018**.
